#### **The Shooting Segment**

The shooting portion of our shooting and ball handling conditioning program includes the fundamental mechanics necessary to become a successful shooter from the block to beyond the three-point line. Instruction and drills will focus on shooting from a stationary position, off the dribble, and off the pass.

**From Michigan:** 23 south Dussel-Salisbury Rd. exit, turn left, go through 5 traffic lights, turn left on Market Place Drive (first street after the fifth light), road dead ends in the Academy's parking lot.

**From Michigan:** 75 south to 475 to 23 to Dussel-Salisbury Road, then proceed as above.
